<u>Create a Character Trading Card</u>: Choose a Character from a book you read this summer and create a Character Trading Card. You can create and print your trading card at http://www.readwritethink.org/files/resources/interactives/trading_cards_2/

<u>Create a Bookmark</u>: Hand draw a bookmark or design one on the computer. on one side, include your name, the book title, and author. on the other side, illustrate or state the main character(s), setting, problem, and solution of a book you read this summer.

<u>Create a Die</u>: Create a 6-sided die and use each side to share the following information. There is a printable template available on the media center website under summer Reading.

- 1. Title and author
- 2. Setting
- 3. Problem
- 4. Solution
- 5. Characters
- 6. Illustration of your favorite part

<u>create a wordle</u>: Go to <u>http://www.wordle.net/</u> to create and print your wordle by typing in words that describe the following:

- 1. Tile and author
- 2. Setting
- 3. Problem
- 4. Solution
- 5. Characters

wordle tips:

- The more times you type a word, the bigger it will be in your wordle. Therefore, if you want the title to be the biggest, type it the most times.
- If you want to keep multiple words together, leave out the spaces. For example, if your title is *diary of a wimpy kid*, type it as diaryofawimpykid.
