- Overview of SAC Bylaws/Roberts Rules of Order: Presented by Stacy Giangaspro The SAC Bylaws will be voted on at the next meeting to be held October 3, 2013.
- Overview of School Improvement Plan Process: Presented by Kelly Jacobson The School Improvement Plan is all digital and online this year. The first draft was due on August 30<sup>th</sup>. The final plan is due on September 20<sup>th</sup> and will be presented at a future SAC meeting.

  Bruce is teaching three of these classes totaling about 134 students. The students are using an eTextbook, will earn high school credit, and have the opportunity to become Microsoft Office Specialists.

  Marzano continues as well as Common Core implementation. We are looking at assessments which will be 20/60/20 low, mid, and high level questions. We are excited for teachers to have a planning period this year allowing for more collaborative planning. A group of ten teachers has been established called 2C.IT, for Common Core Implementation Team, who meet twice a month.

  PBMS currently has 1045 students enrolled and every class space is being used. We are looking at adding relocatables next school year. A 7<sup>th</sup> period has been added to allow for teacher planning. We have hired 19 new teachers, 10 of which are new growth positions. We welcome our new Curriculum Coordinator Traci Hemmingway who was

previously an Assistant Principal in Pasco County. Our fall Scholastic Book Fair will be open next week September 9-12<sup>th</sup>. Open House will be held September 10<sup>th</sup>. There will be a Washington DC meeting at 5:15 and an Edmodo training session before Open House begins at 6:00 pm. Pictures will be taken September 10-11<sup>th</sup>. The boys' basketball tryouts are done and girls basketball tryouts will take place today. Mark your calendar for Joseph Joyner's State of the Schools presentation on Monday, October 14<sup>th</sup> 6:00-7:00 pm to be held at the school district administrative building. Mrs. Wilson had her baby boy last month and will return after maternity leave to teach Adventures in Literature. Last year's SAC funds were used for IB training. One of the IB training sessions took place in New Orleans where PBMS was recognized as an IB World school.
