Gifted population: 108

Most gifted population is in 6<sup>th</sup> grade

Interdisciplinary Teams to talk about common students

2 out 4 teams have a 2 gifted certified teachers

Lower quartile students have high expectations at PBMS

IEP/Support Facilitation: IEP teacher in classroom helps support the learning

Yearly meeting and 3 year re-evaluations for ESE; Gifted every 3 years

Safeguards in place for students falling through the cracks (RTI)

504-have a health component that may interfere with their learning

PBMS has 5 support teachers and 2 paraprofessionals to meet the IEP needs

Self-Contained- 8 students; Best Buddies Program

Access Points- into the Gen Ed classroom with modifications

## **Presentation of 2016-2017 School Improvement Plan**

Area of focus: Advanced Placement Programming, advanced coursework

Academic needs as well as social/emotional needs- balance

Goal: Supporting social/emotional students

"Not just a number" – want children to feel like they belong

Parents requested more after school activities so PBMS entered into a partnership with the YMCA

Already have 80 kids- allows kids to feel connected to the community and school

46 students in our After the Bell program- tutor leads the program

WEB- Where Everybody Belongs; kids have chances to meet with their mentors during Wednesday

PAWS sessions and lunch. Students are enjoying the time together and Jay has noticed lower stress levels amongst our sixth graders.

I-teams- will be maintained next year as well.

Letter from Governor Scott stating that PBMS was ranked 52 in our ELA achievement score out of 578 schools. Science was ranked 21 (proficiency) and math 73<sup>rd</sup>.
