Social Studies Presentation

Sarah Todrick, the SS department chair for Pacetti Bay, presented the focus of the middle school SS curriculum. The SS PLC is recognized district wide as both content leaders and PLC leaders. 6th grade World History covers Geography, Thinking like a Historian, Ancient Cultures and Mythology and Belief Systems. The 6th grade SS classes are flipped classrooms, meaning they take the lecture notes at home. 7th grade civics has a district exam. The 8th grade US history class covers European Colonization to the Revolutionary War. Another focus in 8th grade is career planning and a focus on the Be the Change Program. US History focuses on DBQ's to approach high level thinking. The 8th grade team took 260 students on the DC trip this year.

Testing Update

Caitlyn Stewart, the new Asst. Principal, provided a hard copy of the testing schedule for those in attendance. Additionally, she directed everyone to the web site which also has the testing dates. The EOC Exams were switched the FSA dates from last year. As of today we have a total of 1484 students currently enrolled at Pacetti Bay.

Next year with Mill Creek operating as a K-7, the numbers are expected to drop about 100 students. Projected to be about 1371 students for the 19-20 school year. We are allowed to keep all portables for next school year. Pacetti is not reducing the physical plant size.

The housing development of Silver Leaf is currently in our attendance zone.
