2. Ted Talks:
 - a. SIP or school Improvement Plan. Mr Banton is in the process of submitting the plan to the district. Our delay was due to the State of Florida releasing critical data for PBMS to create a School Improvement plan to adopt.

Highlight of the SIP are:

1. Raise lower quartile ELA performance score. Last year, PBMS score was 41-42%. Mr Banton noted our efforts are to implement improvement in the lower quartile scores for overall score improvement.
 2. 7th and 8th grade is staying at the same levels. Lowest quartile moved up from 56% to 60% and we still have room for improvement
 3. PBMS plans to implement PBIS for our school to celebrate success in students that DO not normally receive any accolades. The goal is to develop an awareness in the students and the staff to promote successful behavior in all students along academic success.
 4. In addition to the above, the SIP plan will focus on Students with Disabilities, (SWD), All means all, we need, as a school to raise the percentage of our SWD students making grade level gains.
- b. Mr. Banton mentioned the school is down to one teacher needed. The Math teacher slated to replaces the late Ms. Mccay will start in 10 days.
 - c. Memorial service for MS. Mccay was wonderful due to former students appearing at the event and were involved in the services. Mr. Banton spoke well of her and said great things on behalf of the school.
 - d. Mr. Banton wished Dawn Gillis best of luck as she transfers to a new position with Piccolata Elementary school shortly. Mr. Banton praised her efforts and her devout contribution to the events and happenings at Pacetti Bay Middle School and that she will be missed by all.
 - e. Grades for the 1st Quarter will be out.
