- PTSO School dance was a success. One of the first school wide affairs since the onset of COVID. Great turnouts from the students, great fun, few incidents.
- Planning has begun for the 8th grade Prom/Dance along with an awards ceremony to celebrate the students
- Projected growth for the upcoming years with greater growth once the K-3 students age for middle school. The area has a very large population of K-3 students.

- Admin is looking to add SWIPE for tardy students. Students that are late need to 'swipe' their student ID prior to entering a classroom/bldg. The 'swipe' records their information, informs the student of the number of tardies and create a classroom pass for the student.
- Update on the concrete pad for the students outside lunch area. Mr Banton said the district was astonished-"why do you need this?"
- Area rezoning is underway-most changes effect the K-7 students.
