1. Meeting started 2:16pm
2. **Financial update:** Mr. Laga spoke on the finances. He noted was an expenditure of \$707.21 for PBIS funding.
3. Ms. Winter requested funds for next year's PBIS program. She mentioned the success of the program and the interest the students had in the process. Ms. Winter said the amount spent last year was \$4875.00. Her request form was for \$1000.00. Mr. Laga and Mr. Manias offered \$2000.00. The offer was seconded, and the motion was passed.
4. Mr. Laga discussed the SRF program with the committee. The teachers, Support staff, kitchen staff and custodial staff has created a plan for the funds, voted on the options and the SAC Committee needs to approve the process. The approval was unanimous.
5. **Ted Talks:**
 - a. Gradventure went well without any major problems. Thanks to Ms. Cooper and Ms. Leitao.
 - b. Testing has gone well. Kudos to Savannah Sims for all of her hard work. At this time, we have tested 96% of PBMS students.
 - c. 6th and 7th grade level trips are yet to come.
 - b. **Yearbooks.** We are receiving them and will have signings on the 26th and the 27th.
 - d. **School Staffing.** For the upcoming School year are finished-unless a position opens at PBMS.
 - e. School faculty vs students to be held again this year.
 - f. Mr. Banton discussed the new state testing program with the committee. The first year is the baseline for the test to determine the data. Banton would prefer to do the first test ASAP in the new school year as to not interfere with the content of the teachers. The district is reducing the EOC numbers from 266 to 44 tests. Many content areas are going to end without the EOC.
 - g. Staffing is going well. Banton needs to fill the growth positions. Next years population should be over 1400 students.
