- 1. Meeting started 2:15pm
- 2. **Financial update**: Mr. Laga spoke on the finances and how an error had appeared on the budget list. Mr Laga mentioned to the Committee he had the errors corrected.
- 3. SAC by laws and Robert's Rules were approved by the SAC Committee.
- 4. **Media Center Advisory group.** Karin Gowens, media specialist, gave out information to the committee regarding the Media Center Advisory group's duties have stepped up, due to more parental involvement in the media center purchase of materials, books, picture books etc. She mentioned the State of Florida has placed a hold on book purchasing until January, when the state will develop a plan of what to purchase for each grade level.

Attendance is better that the past (no covid) and the students. Are adjusting brick and mortar. The weekly newsletter has a parent survey that Mr. Banton prodded the committee to recruit their friends and neighbors to complete. The survey is for the district's audit this year.

Looking ahead: Spirit week is next week, Unity Day went off well except for the face painting of bus seats.

Positions: the ELA position has been filled but the science has not. Banton was remaining positive that only one position is open.

For the summer: new capital projects are coming.

There will not be a DC trip due to costs. Gradventure is the process being booked for next year.
