7<sup>th</sup> grade Science Teacher, Ben Aufdenberg, made a request on behalf of the entire science department to fund Generation Genius for the school year. The program is no longer funded through the district, and the teachers would like to continue to use this resource.

The team made a motion to approve the funding of Generation Genius for \$1395.00 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher, John Manias, made a request for funding to aid with PBIS. The school uses PBIS rewards as a positive behavior system for all students. He runs the school store and the game room, which are used as student incentives to earn and redeem points.

The team approved the request of \$1500.00 to purchase rewards for PBIS.

The school principal, Mrs. Murphy, presented the SIP plan for the school year. She reviewed areas of growth and weaknesses for the school and shared the goals for the year. Part of this year's goal is increasing student achievement, with a focus on 7<sup>th</sup> grade math scores.

Testing continues this week and wraps up on Monday with 6<sup>th</sup> grade math. PTSO sponsored color run is next Thursday, Sept 18. It's the big school fundraiser for the year. PTSO is also planning a fall dance. Details TBA.
