RSV (Returning Student Verification):

The RSV must be completed in order for your student to have a schedule on the first day of school. Every summer, the School District requires parents to complete the returning student verification (RSV) form online. Parents must complete the returning student verification for each child separately. Parents should have received an email from: noreplyregistration@powerschool.com. This will be sent to you each week until it is completed. This must be completed so families may view their student's middle school schedule on 7/24/24.

Rising 6th Graders:

Updated proof of residency must be provided, and the Returning Student Verification (RSV) completed for your student to have a schedule on the first day of school. When you complete the RSV online you can upload proof of residency at the same time. New students to St. Johns County will upload proof of residency when registering.

Rising 7th Graders:

7th grade students are required to have a Tdap and updated FL680 immunization form on file. Students will not receive a schedule until records are received. Lockers:



Lunch Accounts:

Clinic Information:

If your student will be carrying non-prescription medication, the following form must be filled out <u>Self-Administer</u> <u>Over the Counter Form</u> and provided to our nurse. If your student needs or may need prescription medication, the following form must be filled out and signed by a physician. <u>Prescription Medication Authorization</u>. The prescription medication must be handed to our nurse by a parent. Nurse Lewis will be available during "Meet The Teacher" Aug 9th 12:30-3:30pm at the ticket booth by the gym.

Transportation:

Students can walk, bike, or be dropped off using our car line. Students who live outside of the 2 mile range will be assigned a bus. A representative from transportation will be on campus during "Meet The Teacher" Aug 9th to answer any questions. Bikes should be locked, and students are asked to wear a helmet. Car line opens up at 6:55am.

Schoology:
